The day began with the player auction, providing some fierce bidding on some of the well known players, accumulating a massive \$1650 pool of cash for the Calcutta alone.

Juniors, Ladies & Men all competed for the \$1000 competition prize pool, seeing young Luke Anglesey, age 15, take some serious scalps over the course of the day to place 4th & collect \$52.50 & the top placed Junior trophy. Rebecca Eves was in great form showing the blokes a thing or two about the art of a technical game of 8Ball, getting through 6 rounds before being knocked out, placing as the top Lady for the day.
