Saturday May 11th saw Three of Miss Q's Star Juniors Daniel Kew, Stone Stenhouse & Alex Kingsbury play in the Under 15's and at the end of a very long day Stone Stenhouse finished with his second State Under 15's Champion Title for this year one in 8 Ball and now backing it up in the Snooker Alex Kingsbury another Miss Q's Leagueie and star 8 Ball Player took the Champion Under 15's Runner Up Honours in a huge final that could have gone either way on the day with both juniors playing very well. Congratulations Stone & Alex way to make everyone at Miss Q's proud. The Following Saturday May 19th saw the Under 12's and Under 18's go toe to toe on the big tables with Miss Q's Juniors Holly-Jane Vaelua, Alex Kingsbury & Stone Stenhouse representing.
